


Turnout by county*






Looking at Trump's performance by county

North Carolina Trump County Performance Relative to His Statewide Performance (51%) of the Vote




Change in Trump vote 2020 to 2024






Comparing Trump vote 2016-2024

Percentage Growth/Decline in Votes from Trump 2016 to Trump 2024 in North Carolina (22% Shift)




Comparing Biden 2020 vote to Harris 2024


North Carolina 2024 General Elections Federal vs State 2-Party Results





Electoral Margin and Ballot Roll Off for NC Statewide Elections 2024





Trump Gained Ground Across Demographic Groups





Fundamental #1: Right Track-Wrong Track

Two-thirds of voters say the U.S. is on the wrong track

It's the lowest share in three years of NBC News polling, but it's also very close to voters' verdict when they decided to change the party in the White House in 2016 and 2020.





Right Direction/Wrong Track

The right direction/wrong track poll question is a great predictor of whether a party retains or loses the White House







Americans' Views on Transgender Athletes, Based on Familiarity With a Transgender Person, 2021 vs. 2023


Do you think transgender athletes should be able to play on sports teams that match their current gender identity or should only be allowed to play on sports teams that match their birth gender?

■ % Able to play on teams that match identity ■ % Only on teams that match birth gender ■ % No opinion







Dems losing working class because they are not talking working class issues




Percentage of candidates

Abortion did not help Ds as much as some thought








